Some words from the board...

This time I was asked to write a short piece for the Arriblad on behalf of the board. I'm the secretary of Arriba and my name is Hans Wennemers. Most of you probably know me already, because I've been a member of Arriba for several years.

I'd like to start with the competition. The season is already at the second half. Almost all the teams have won matches and Gents 1 was really close to their first victory. They came back from a behind really well, but could not finish it and after overtime they unfortunately lost. It shows, however, that there are possibilities to win a match. Conversely Gents 2 has almost won all their matches. They can become champion and they are only 3 points behind the leader in the competition. Gents 3 and Gents 4 are in the same competition and both teams have won about 50% of the matches. These teams are matched and it will be exciting to see who will be placed highest at the end of the season. The mutual score is 1-1 with one match left to go. Last but not least, there is Ladies- 1-team. They won two matches, but they will probably win some more. Two weeks ago, with only 5 players they almost defeated the team that was place first.

Enough about the competition, let's focus what the rest of the season will bring to Arriba. On Sunday the 12th of Februari there will be the FlaBa. This is a basketball-tournament, organized by Arriba, where you can participate with a team that consist of housemates, fellow students, friends or other people you know. And there is more fun coming up: next month an Arriba-party will be organized and on Saturday the 28th of April the Batavierenrace will take place and Arriba will join in. It is an event you cannot miss. In the near future a list will be put up where you can sign in for the Batavierenrace. From the 8th till the 10th of June the Breedtetournament hopefully will take place. This is the biggest Tournament of Arriba, where also external teams will participate in. And let's not forget the Summerleague and the slottournament, which also will take place this year.

There are still some committees that need people to join. The tournament-committee (Toecie) is looking for an extra member, so they can make sure the Breedtetournament can be organized. And also the batavierenrace-committie (Batacie) is looking for an extra member, because it exists of only one person at this moment. Furthermore, it would be nice if somebody could join the party-committee (Feescie), so that it consists of 3 persons. If you like to help Arriba out, please let the board or the committees know.

But there is also good news. Sint-Arriba-Klaas was a big party. The New-years-tournament, organized by the tournament-committee was successful and everybody was having fun (and had sore muscles afterwards ;)). The Arriblad-committee is doing a good job by launching this second edition of the Arriblad this season. The bar shifts can be filled relatively easy. A Kasco has been charged during the last General Members meeting and there is an Advisory Council again, which wasn't there for a long time.

And there is more news. Since October we have an extra trainings time in the Sports Centre (thanks to Gijs) on Wednesday, which means that we have less training in the ROC. The 24-second-clock now has an 14-second button, thanks to Sander who programmed a new chip. Bob has joined the Toecie, so the chances that the Breedtetournament can go on are bigger now. The Arriba-closets in the Sports Centre are cleaned up. The website (dbvarriba.nl) is still up to date and includes pictures of the teampresentations and Sint-Arriba-klaas, an overview of the match and task schedule and more stuff. The Arriba-caravan still exists and is located at a secure place at the Witbreuksweg. Since December Arriba has 8 new F-referees and this week a trainings course will start and Davey and Rik will participate in this course.

But there are also some problems. The biggest problem is that trainings schedule is not optimized. On Wednesdays most of the times the centre court is set up and this is a waste of the available space. The combined training of the Ladies on Mondays gives some problems. Gents 3 and Gents 4 have trainings on two days in a row and don't have separate trainings and Gents 2 has a training once a week in the ROC. We want to solve these problems, but don't know how. If there are suggestions, please let the board know.

To conclude, I want to thank all the committee members, team captains, referees, coaches, trainers and so on for all the help, because without you Arriba cannot survive! Furthermore, I like to wish everybody good luck with the rest of the season, have fun and of course good luck with the exams.

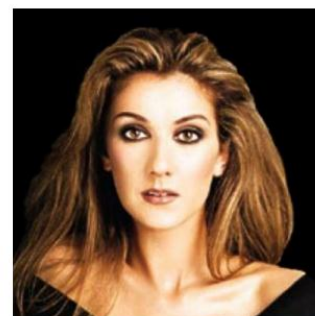
